
Dodge City Middle School Lexile Growth Charts2012 - 2013

The DCMS Target Goal for reading was to have an overall increase of 34 Lexile points by the end of January of 2013. After 80 days of instruction our school <u>average Lexile gain was 43.16</u> which is a 9 point gain over our target goal.

- What percent of our students in 6th grade had a 40 point Lexile gain in 80 days? <u>49%</u>
- What percent of our students in 7th grade had a 34 point Lexile gain in 80 days? <u>34%</u>
- What percent of our students in 8th grade had a 29 point Lexile gain in 80 days? <u>46.5%</u>
