
**What:** A special reading reception for students and parent/guardian. Please bring reading log with parent signature.





Summer is finally here – a time for our students to have a break from school and spend more time with the family. Studies show the summer is when our stu-

dents are at risk of losing some of their reading skills. So, let's make sure they have a good book in their hands while away from the classroom. With the Find-a-Book Web site, www.lexile.com/findabook, your child can do just that. They can find books that will help them continue learning – and learn to love reading.

#### It's easy to take the challenge!

- Keep track of the number of minutes you read on the Summer Reading Log.
- Record on your reading log the Lexile level of the books you read, title and author.
- Determine your award level and attend one of the "Back to School Nights" where you will receive a certificate and your non-uniform day bracelets.
- Parent signature must be on your reading log and a parent/ guardian must attend in order for you to receive your reading award.

#### **Incentives**

This summer Dodge City Middle School has established a special reading incentive program that will help motivate students in grades six, seven and eight to read more over the summer months. Students can earn up to ten non-uniform days during the summer by recording reading minutes.



#### SUMMER READING LEVELS



Bronze Reading Level (500 Min.)
Read 10 minutes a day 5 days a week and earn 2 non-uniform days



Silver Reading Level (750 Min.)
Read 15 minutes a day 5 days a week and earn 4 non-uniform days



Gold Reading Level (1000 Min.)
Read 20 minutes a day 5 days a week
and earn 6 non-uniform days



Platinum Reading Level (1250 Min.) Read 25 minutes a day 5 days a week and earn 8 non-uniform days



**Diamond Reading Level** (1500 Min.) Read 30 minutes a day 5 days a week and earn 10 non-uniform days

#### **How Can I Participate?**

In your summer reading packet is a reading log that needs to be filled out over the summer months.

#### **How Do I Get My Awards?**

You must attend the reading reception celebration event with your parent (s) or a guardian (over 18 years of age) and bring your reading log with a parent signature.

#### **How Do I Get More Reading Logs?**

If you lose your reading log or need more, you can go to the summer reading program website. At the website you can learn more about the program, download reading logs, and find other useful material.

#### When is the Reading Awards Reception?

The Reading Award Reception information is on the back of the brochure.

#### When does the program start and end?

The program starts on June 1st and ends on August 14th.
